Colorado Companies to Watch honors second stage companies that develop valuable products and services, create quality jobs, enrich communities and create new industries throughout Colorado. From 2007 through 2010, these companies generated \$975 million in revenue and added 851 employees (both in Colorado and out of state), reflecting a 114 percent increase in revenue and 123 percent increase in jobs for the four-year period. The Colorado Office of Economic Development and International Trade launched the program in 2009 in conjunction with the Edward Lowe Foundation and other community partners.

In addition, EnergyLogic was ranked the fourth-fastest growing private company in Larimer and Weld Counties by the *Northern Colorado Business Report* in their annual [Mercury 100 Report](#). Revenue increased 142 percent from 2009 to 2010. The firm has 80 employees, up from 20 employees in 2008.

EnergyLogic is a leading provider of home energy efficiency services, consulting, training, and software services. Since its founding in 2006, the firm has completed more than 10,000 home energy audits, trained more than 400 energy raters and auditors across the United States and developed two software tools.
